In his younger years Kenny won several gold and silver medals at Special Olympics games, most notably in 1979 when he won gold at the International Special Olympics in New York. He was also on the Special Olympics Bowling team.

In the last few years Kenny was the guy who sat in his scooter at the north end of the mall, collecting bottles and cans.
