Mildred "Faye" Cameron (née Culley) October 4, 1951 - January 16, 2019 Faye Cameron left us on her last journey, after a near two-year battle with ovarian cancer, at the age of 67. She died peacefully at Powell River General Hospital with family at her side. Faye was born in Regina, Saskatchewan, and moved with her parents to Powell River when she was six weeks old. She grew up on Fernwood Avenue and attended Edgehill Elementary School, then graduated from Max Cameron. At 19, she began work at the Bank of Montreal, where she worked for 36 years. She also enjoyed the simple pleasures of life, such as a hot cup of tea, a well-tended garden, nature walks and summer barbecues with family and friends.
