Pat died suddenly at his home in Van Anda on Sunday, April 21, 2019. He was 77 years old and had been seriously ill for some time. Pat moved to Texada in the mid-90s and made his home there. He worked for BC Ferries on the Blubber Bay-Westview route until his retirement.
